A single grant of £325 per academic year (August 2026 to July 2027) is available to support education costs, not funded by statutory provision, of primary school children who are permanent residents of the Strathnairn Community Council area.

This grant is only available to pupils not attending Farr or Daviot Primary Schools as Strathnairn Community Benefit Fund makes awards directly to the Parent Councils of Farr and Daviot Schools to assist with non-statutory education costs.

If you received an Education Grant in 2025/26, you must submit a monitoring form showing how the award was spent before applying for a 2026/27 grant. The monitoring form was sent with your grant award letter. Copies are available from the SCBF website, or by emailing cosec@strathnairncbf.com.

If you are awarded a grant for 2026/27, awards for future academic years will be dependent on the submission of a monitoring form.
